CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

OBJECTIVE

In honour of the 150th anniversary of Canada and Ontario since Confederation, we are celebrating the women and men who work tirelessly to build our community.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nominations will be accepted for three age groups: youth (12-25 at the time of nomination), women (26+) and men (26+). Nominees do not need to reside in the riding of Burlington, but their leadership and work must have helped build up our community.

Nominees must have worked to improve the community of Burlington in one of the following ways:

- Celebrate diversity/inclusion
- Build community/capacity
- Protect the heritage of Burlington
- Protect the environment
- Promote a healthy community

NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

All submissions must include:

1. A completed nomination form, including nominee information and nominator information.
2. Supporting documents including:
 - A. Minimum (1) letter of support: the letters must be unique to each nominee and show how the nominee's work has benefited the community of Burlington. Letters may be submitted by a community leader, mentor, teacher or another individual who has experience mentoring working with, or volunteering with the nominee.
 - B. Information about the person being nominated (maximum of 250 words each)
